## Order

1. Pending before the Court is Plaintiff Laura Hammett's February 7, 2025,

"Motion to Continue Case and Certify for Interlocutory Appeal of Order to Order to Continue Case

- Arbitrate." Based on review of the motion, briefing, and applicable law, the Court hereby GRANTS the motion.
- 2. The Court notices that the contract attached to the complaint as an exhibit was not provided to Hammett before payment of the warranty fee. Hammett rescinded the same contract on a policy covering a different property.
  Rescision was not an adequate remedy on the Gold Lake Club property, because the forced air unit failed prior to receipt of the contract. A replacement policy from a different company would not cover the conditions that were known to exist before purchase.
- 3. Therefore the contract was reformed, according to the verbal contract described in the complaint, which must be taken as a true and accurate fact before summary judgment.
- 4. Hammett agreed to stipulate to non-binding arbitration or mediation paid for in full by the defendants. Because AAA refuses to hold a non-binding arbitration, the parties may stipulate to a different arbitrator or mediator, paid for by the Defendants, or continue to discovery in the Court.
- 5. Because a reasonable person might reasonably believe that the undersigned has a bias against Hammett, the undersigned recuses herself from further proceedings in which Hammett is a litigant.
