**Motion for 10 Day Stay**


COME NOW Plaintiffs, Laura Hammett and Sean Lynn, appearing pro se, and respectfully move the Court for a temporary stay of proceedings from June 20, 2026, through June 30, 2026, and state as follows:

1. Plaintiffs are proceeding pro se and therefore do not have counsel or staff available to manage litigation responsibilities during periods when they are unavailable.
2. Laura Hammett is currently receiving treatment from a licensed mental health professional. A letter from her therapist supporting a ten-day period away from work-related responsibilities is attached as Exhibit 15.
3. Laura Hammett's therapist has recommended that she be excused from all work duties for ten consecutive days to address increased PTSD-related symptoms and to promote stabilization and recovery. During the requested stay period, Laura Hammett intends to

spend time with Plaintiff Sean Lynn and participate in activities conducive to her mental health and emotional well-being.

4. Sean Lynn suffers from post-traumatic epilepsy and has already experienced a seizure during his current work assignment. A substantial portion of Laura Hammett's anxiety arises from concern regarding his ongoing medical condition and the possibility of future seizures. Spending time with Sean Lynn during the requested stay period is expected to benefit both Plaintiffs' mental and physical well-being.
5. One of the central allegations in this case is that Sean Lynn had a substantial opportunity for recovery after January 13, 2024, but instead suffered additional injury during the events that followed, which Plaintiffs allege ultimately resulted in post-traumatic epilepsy. The possibility of future seizures therefore remains a significant source of stress for both Plaintiffs.
6. The requested stay is sought in good faith and not for purposes of delay.
7. To the best of Plaintiffs' knowledge, all deadlines presently applicable to Plaintiffs before the requested stay period occur prior to June 20, 2026.
8. The requested stay is limited in duration and is intended to allow Plaintiff Laura Hammett a brief period to attend to health-related needs, participate in recommended therapeutic interventions, and reduce the burden of ongoing litigation activities.
9. Plaintiffs conferred with opposing counsel regarding this request on April 26, 2026, and again on June 4, 2026. Opposing counsel has stated that Defendants do not consent to the requested stay.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiffs respectfully request that the Court enter an Order staying all proceedings and deadlines affecting Plaintiffs from June 20, 2026, through June 30, 2026, and granting such other and further relief as the Court deems just and proper.

Letter from Therapist Supporting Need for 10-day Stay



June 1, 2026

To Whom It May Concern:

I am writing on behalf of my client, Laura Hammett, DOB: August 14, 1962, who resides at 16 Gold Lake Club Road, Conway, Arkansas 72032.

Ms. Hammett has been a long-term client under my care, and I am familiar with her mental health history, current mental status, and diagnosis of Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD). Due to recent circumstances and stressors, she is currently experiencing an increase in PTSD-related symptoms that are adversely affecting her overall functioning and well-being.

To support her stabilization and recovery, I am recommending that Ms. Hammett be excused from all work duties for a period of ten (10) consecutive days. This time away from work will allow her to participate in additional therapeutic interventions and treatment sessions aimed at reducing symptoms, improving coping skills, and promoting emotional stabilization.
